MORNINGS ARE OPEN FOR INDEPENDENT STUDYING, GROUP PROJECTS, PLAYING GAMES, AND HANGING OUT WITH FRIENDS.

AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES INCLUDE ELECTIVES AND CLASSES THAT KIDS CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE IN.

CLASSES INCLUDE A ROTATING ROSTER OF TOPICS SUCH AS SPANISH, BUILDING & WOODWORKING, ART, ECOLOGY, HEALTH, PE, PHILOSOPHY, ART & MATH, TECH, CODING, DRAMA, DEBATE, HISTORY, ETC. PARTICIPANTS CHOOSE TWO ELECTIVES EACH AFTERNOON THEY ATTEND.

COMMUNITY MEETINGS

Weekly virtual all-community meeting for Birch Boundless participants, Birch School students and all the teachers and advisors for both programs.

This 45 minute inclusive Zoom meeting involves community building activities, discussing and organizing student initiatives, group games, announcements, and short relevant lessons and discussions.

ADVISORY

Participants also get a bi-weekly one-on-one 15-minute virtual Advisory meeting.

Advisors are adult teachers, facilitators and counselors from the Birch team. Kids have the same advisor for each session.

For kids who are considering college and or career choices and opportunities Birch also offers support and guidance.



FOR PARENTS & CAREGIVERS

For parents and guardians who are homeschooling teens and high school students Birch offers additional support. We offer a monthly virtual support meeting for caregivers, with a topic of interest such as keeping records, transcripts and diplomas, meeting state requirements, finding opportunities and supporting kids' interests, how to identify learning challenges and differences, supporting gifted and talented kids and more. This is an opportunity for parents and guardians to share experiences and help one another on the journey.

ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

Birch Boundless participants are welcome and encouraged to participate in all-school activities and events, such as our twice-yearly student showcase (a virtual and in-person display of student work), poetry slams, seasonal celebrations and end-of-year awards, yearbook and graduation.

OUR RESOURCES

Birch's extensive library of curriculum, textbooks, reference materials, Young Adult fiction, classic fiction, resources on educational philosophy, student goal setting, homeschool challenges, college planning, and more are available for signout on loan as part of the program.

TRY SOMETHING NEW,

HAVE FUN LEARNING

Students spend up to three days per week on-site, participating in classes, projects, trips and hanging out. Weekly meetings with an advisor are held virtually. In addition, families meet with educators several times per school year to assist with plans, recordkeeping and accountability.

OUR GOALS

Since our goals include curating a kind and stable community of learners, we request a commitment to the program. This means that family members support the learner attending, that the learner agrees to attend regularly and to participate in the program offerings. To facilitate this commitment, we are offering this program in three eleven week sessions. These twice weekly sessions are supervised and facilitated by Birch staff dedicated to this program. The personal relationships and group dynamics that develop among staff and participants is a key focus of our program and we are committed to ensuring that all participants remain safe, both physically and emotionally.

We will offer Birch Boundless program for up to 12 participants, with a goal for six participants ages 11-14 and for six participants ages 15-17.
